

Job Title –Internship for Community Development

Duration- Minimum 5 weeks

Location – Saketri, Panchkula

About the Project- Saketri slum has the unenviable reputation of being the most deprived and neglected slum dwelling in the tricity. Its population is mainly of rural migrants from U.P. They live in extreme poverty with lack of basic amenities like water, electricity, toilet, sewage, health, education and other social welfare programs. Bhawan Vidyalaya, Rotary Club Service Trust Chandigarh and SEWA (Self Employment Women’s Association) are the three organizations which have come together to work towards promoting healthcare and sanitation, making drinking water available, promoting education, livelihood enhancement training, empowering women and overall capacity building of the community in this slum area.

About the Internship (Role and Duties) –

The Intern needs to take complete responsibility of day to day monitoring of building of drains, toilets and over all Development of the area.

1. (i) Plan network of open drains of every cluster of the slums as per the topography
(ii) Supervise and monitor the construction of the drains according to the specifications.
2. (i) Plan suitable location(s) for construction of toilets and washing areas for each cluster.
(ii) Plan, supervise and monitor the construction of the toilets and washing areas
3. To plan a cost effective and efficient solid waste management.
4. Plan and monitor construction of soak pits.
5. Plan and develop rain water harvesting sites.

Who can apply-

1. Candidates who are available for work from Monday – Friday
2. Can start the internship as soon as possible
3. Are available for duration of minimum a month
4. Have relevant skill and interests.
5. Candidates who have their own conveyance will be preferred.

Perks-

1. An allowance of Rs 500 per week, to meet cost towards conveyance and out of pocket expense while at site
2. Certification will be provided by the three organizations.
